To conduct an examination session a minimum level of fees are required.

The fees for each daily session must amount to a minimum of £425.00 for an in-person exam session or £225 for a live stream exam session. All professional fees are included for the purpose of assessing minimum session fees. A surcharge will be applied for sessions which do not reach the minimum session fee.

A discount for prompt payment of 20% is given on the fees which exceed £300.00 for all schools who produce more than £425.00 in fees. (Associate, Licentiate, Fellowship and Diploma examinations are not included for assessing discount). Discount is given on accounts settled within 30 days from the invoice date.

The fee stated is charged by the IDTA to the member teacher per pupil per examination. The IDTA provides a report form and certificate and or awards as appropriate. There will be additional charges added to these fees by the teacher to cover all overheads e.g. administration costs, staff costs heating, lighting studio costs, Public Liability Insurance etc... and this will vary from school to school and region to region.
